There are many situations in which Deaf interpreters may be used. These include meetings, Child Protective Services, IEP meetings, Educational K- 12, colleges and universities, medical appointments, consultations, Physical and Occupational Therapy, mental health assessments and counselling, legal situations and courtroom, for Deaf and Blind and low vision, entertainment venues, press conferences, vocational rehab, job training, independent living, and taking driver's license written tests.
